

SHOALS COVID ONLINE POLICY

If a student is enrolled in the COVID online program and/or e-learning, he/she is expected to log 3-5 hours daily during regular school hours or the equivalent of 15-25 hours per week. Students who are working and complete their online work during non-school hours must still meet the required hours per week and stay in communication with the COVID online instructor and/or an administrator. Weekly communication and progress reports are sent out to each individual student by the COVID online instructor. These reports itemize the individual progress for each enrolled class. If at any time during the semester, it is determined that the individual progress and daily log time of a student have not been sufficient with the online requirements and the student is falling behind, the student will be referred to the Martin County Probation Department and/or the Department of Child Services.
