

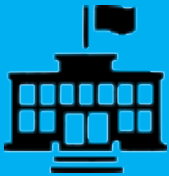


Shoals Community Schools Reopening Plan

A Collaboration of All Daviess/Martin County School's as of (7-8-20)

THURSDAY, AUGUST 6, 2020

- School starts on-time, in-person, 5 days a week
- Online learning option from home available
(Note: The online curriculum will be limited and cannot mirror the full curriculum/experience of in-person instruction.)

ENHANCED CLEANING PROTOCOL

Increased number of hand sanitizer stations in all classrooms & key locations

Safe, effective, hospital strength sanitizing agents used on schedule throughout the day on all high-touch areas in the school/classroom and on buses

Virus-killing fog machines purchased for use in contaminated areas

COVID POSITIVE PROTOCOL

Individuals will be quarantined for 14 days before returning to school. Contact tracing and guidance provided by the Martin County Health Department.

OTHER ILLNESSES

Shoals will be following the ISDH guidelines for the readmission of students/staff to school.

HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOL



HAND WASHING

Hand washing will be required throughout the day. Additional hand sanitizer will be available in each classroom.



WATER BOTTLES

Students will be allowed to carry water bottles. All water fountains will be used only for the purpose of filling the bottles.



STAY HOME IF SICK

Self-monitor daily temperature and symptom screening before coming to school.



CLINIC LOCATIONS

Students with COVID symptoms will be separated from other students.



TRAINING

Professional development will be provided to all staff at start of school year on symptoms, screening measures, and prevention.



ASSIGNED SEATING

Seating charts will be required on buses, in classrooms, and in the cafeteria. Siblings will be seated together on buses.



MASKS

Masks/face coverings are strongly recommended (not required). The ISDH and DCHD/MCHD cites a 40-60% reduction in COVID-19 transmission when masks are used. Social distancing may not be possible at all times (bus, hallway, clinics, group work). In those cases, schools may ask that masks/coverings be utilized.

CHANGES TO THE CLASSROOM / SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT

SCHOOL EVENTS

- Events (i.e. athletics, concerts) may be held with social distancing and limited family participation in a highly structured environment.

CLASSROOMS

- Changes will be made to classrooms to create more personal space (reduce furniture, spread out desks, define areas, etc.). Students will face in the same direction in a classroom as much as possible.
- Students will be required to immediately report to classrooms or the cafeteria (for breakfast) upon entering school and not allowed to congregate in the hallways.
- We will minimize sharing of supplies.

CAFETERIA ADJUSTMENTS

- No visitors for lunch
- Adjustments made to serving lines
- Extra time between lunches for additional cleaning of eating areas
- Classes will sit together at lunch to assist with contact tracing
- Seating charts will be used in all cafeterias

P.E.

Students in required P.E. class will not dress out/change in locker rooms.

RECESS

Playground equipment will be sanitized but recess will remain as normal.

FRONT OFFICES

Plexiglass barriers are installed in front offices.

SCHEDULES

Schedules will remain the same with encouraged hand washing throughout the day.

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- No external field trips or convocations until further notice
 - Visitors / guests who must enter the school (i.e. to pick up a student) will be limited to the office only
 - Volunteers (during the day) will not be scheduled until further notice
 - Students participating in online learning will not be permitted to participate in extracurricular activities

OTHER PREVENTION ITEMS

Eliminate perfect attendance incentives for students during the 2020-2021 school year
